Dear Ms. Liu and Ms. Xu,

On behalf of Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, we would like to thank you for your letter and your support to the United Nations in our global efforts to combat the novel Coronavirus.

Although the United Nations Headquarters is closed to the public due to the pandemic, until 31 May or further notice, we are working hard to adjust our activities to the new reality and to finding creative ways to maintaining our regular engagement by organizing virtual briefings. My team, the Civil Society Unit in the Department of Global Communications (DGC), as you already know, organized a virtual briefing in observance of World Health Day and the 2020 International Year of the Nurse and Midwife on 7 April. We recognize that nurses, healthcare workers and first responders around the world are front and centre of the COVID-19 crisis. We invite you to view the virtual briefing here.

At the United Nations we are more than ever committed to working together on this global response, especially with the youth community. For this reason, the Secretary-General's Envoy on Youth, in partnership with the World Health Organisation and UNICEF, is hosting a series of webinars for young people, titled <u>"#CopingWithCOVID"</u>.
